

The Iqaluit Rotary Club, CKIQ, and the Lotteries Licensing section of Community & Government Services (CGS) wishes to advise the general public on the rules of Lottery License No. IQ10-1026, the Rotary Radio Bingo.

The following is an excerpt from a September 16, 2010 letter to Rotary from CGS.

“The department has examined Lottery License No. IQ10-026 “The Progressive Jackpot game opening with \$5,000 in 47 numbers increasing by \$1,000 and 1 number to a maximum of \$10,000 and 75 numbers.

I’m confirming that the Rotary Club (license holder) had interpreted the license correctly. It was within the rules of the license to award the Consolation Prize of \$3,000 to the recipient.

There are two remaining dates of September 18 and 25, on Saturday 18th of September the jackpot will be \$10,000 in 53 numbers, if the jackpot of \$10,000 is not won in 53 numbers or less than it must be played on September 25th with any numbers as your licence will expire on that date of September 25th.

Jackpots which are carried over shall be played on the expiry of the licence, whether the licence is to be renewed or not.”

CKIQ inadvertently advertised that the jackpot on the week of September 11 ‘must go’ although were advised in August that this was not the case. The management and staff of CKIQ apologize for any misunderstanding this may have caused.
